

Moving to Ohio, as described by John Tipton Barnett (abt. 1807).

"The Ohio Valley was one of the most traveled routes.... Emigrants brought their families and goods by wagon and pack horse to the river bank at Pittsburg.

"The Ohio River was ideally suited to carry migrating people into the wilderness regions where roads were almost non-existent.... An enormous cabin was built on a raft in which entire families floated hundreds of miles with their belongings.

"Each year numerous newly built flatboats made a one-way journey down the Ohio; they were the standard craft of the settlers.... At the end of the voyage the rafts were dismantled, and the lumber... sold or used by the owners to build homes in the new settlements."
