

DAVID TULLIS

Question - Are these descendants of David TULLIS who married Hannah LONGACRE?

Excerpt from letter received from: Bishop Edward L. TULLIS, 1980
Columbia, S.C. (of United Methodist Church).

"The information which I have enclosed for you is taken entirely from cemetery records except for the fact that my grandfather, Edward Brown Tullis, told me some years ago that we were descended from a family in Virginia of which Moses Tullis was the father. It was his understanding that Moses had come from Scotland sometime about the middle of the 1700's. I have seen some records saying that he came from Wales. I do not have this accurate record. My grandfather gave me a list of the names of the children, and I was interested in them particularly because they were all Bible names with the exception of William. My grandfather told me that we had descended from the son of Moses Tullis, whose name was David. David had migrated following the Revolutionary War to Hamilton County, which is now Cincinnati, Ohio. I do not have the record of the next link in the chain, although I know that person was named David Tullis. My great-grandfather David Tullis (1824-1899) records the fact that his father was David Tullis. I do not have the dates of that David. It is not likely that it would be the David who came from Virginia, because, according to my records, there would have been sixty-three years difference between the birth of the David Tullis who came from Virginia (1761) and the birth of my grandfather David Tullis (1824). It is quite likely that the David Tullis who came from Virginia was the grandfather of my great-grandfather. I have not, however, been able to establish this one link in the chain. I am hoping sometime to be able to get to Cincinnati and spend some time checking out that particular record."
