In the name of God, Amen, I, Michael Tullis of the Township of  
Deerfield County of Warren and state of OH being in a low state of  
health is retaining the perfect use of my mental powers to by this  
make my last will and first it is my will that my just debts be  
fully paid and secondly that my wife Elenor Tullis is to have all  
my remaining property and keep it in her possession and do with it  
as may be best pleasing to her for the benefit of the children un-  
til the youngest child shall be of age at which time my wife is to  
have the third of the remainders and rest is to be equally divided  
among the children and thirdly it is my will that my wife Elenor  
shall be the sole executrix and I do give her full power to act as  
such in testimony whereof I shall hereunto set my hand and seal  
this 7th day of Nov 1811.

## A TULLIS BIBLE RECORD

*Claudius Tullis*BIRTHS

Diane Cassidy kindly submitted this Bible record to the TULLIS TRACER. This particular record may be invaluable to those Tullis' who are not descendants of Moses Tullis, the elder, but from an unknown progenitor, as this John Tullis was born before Moses Tullis' son John; therefore, the line could not descend from Moses. Quite possibly Moses and this John were related, perhaps even cousins, but that remains to be seen.

DEATHS

Richard TULLIS - died 12 Oct 1856, in East Fairfield, Columbia County, OH, of Typhoid Fever, aged 62 years, 8 months, and 9 days.

Rachel TULLIS - died 16 Oct 1856, of the same disease, Wife of Richard, aged 56 years, 8 months, 14 days.

Benjamin Franklin TULLIS - First Lieutenant, Company "G", 28th Iowa Infantry, was wounded in the first engagement at Vicksburgh and dies on the 2nd day of May 1863, in the Millikens Bend, Louisiana Hospital, aged 40 years, 2 months, 25 days.
